Play Store set to host all real-money games

Move to hinge on domestic regulation; fees model being "evolved"

Android maker Google on Friday said it will start allowing all real-money games on its Play Store marketplace, as long as they are not illegal under local regulations. The move follows a September, 2022-pilot allowing rummy and what Google classified as 'daily fantasy sports', and will be brought into effect after the pilot ends on 30 June.

The move was welcomed by the online gaming industry, which is reeling from demands of more than ₹1.5 trillion (\$18 billion) from the goods and services tax (GST) regulator.

However, there could be concerns over the kinds of commissions that Google would charge from real-money games. A blog-post published on Thursday by Karan Gambhir, director of global trust and safety partnerships at Google, said the company will be "evolving (the) service fee model for RMG (real money gaming) to reflect the value Google Play provides, and to help sustain Android and Play ecosystems."

Gambhir added that Google is working with industry stakeholders to "ensure our new approach reflects the unique economics and various developer earning models of this industry."

Two officials close to the development, who requested anonymity, said there has been no concrete discussion on what the fees would be from Google, and that a decision on it could only be taken in the months to come.

Google has historically charged developers a 'service fee' of 15% of payments received through the Play Store listing for up to \$1 million in the developer's annual

revenue, and 30% for above \$1 million. For developers that use third-party billing systems, Google charges 11% and 20% for the same revenue threshold. One of the officials cited above told Mint that such a model would prove to be "impractical and unrealistic" in case of real-money games. "The real-money gaming sector already

However, Roland Landers, chief executive of industry body All India Gaming Federation, said the move "will help micro, small and medium enterprises, and new developers or platforms who will be able to compete with established companies by substantially bringing down user acquisition and other associated costs."

Both the industry officials cited above said Google's decision could hinge on regulatory decisions in the sector. Until then, the sector will have access to over 2.5 billion users that Google says accesses its Play Store every month.

The domestic regulatory framework is work in progress a proposal by the ministry of electronics and information technology (MeitY) for the appointment of self-regulatory bodies (SRBs) is believed to have hit a stalemate.

EaseMyTrip eyes ₹1,000 crore fundraise

Online travel platform EaseMyTrip aims to raise ₹1,000 crore in the next 3-4 months as it focuses on acquiring businesses unrelated to aviation, co-founder Prashant Pitti told Mint.

"This would be the first time the company would be taking any external capital. Till today, the company is bootstrapped. We are in the process of empanelling bankers to start the fund-raising. We already have a couple of investors who have shown interest. We expect this to happen over the next 3-4 months," Pitti said.

Earlier this month, the company board gave its in-principle approval for raising up to ₹1,000 crore from the issue of shares and warrants. Last year, EaseMyTrip acquired a majority stake in three Indian travel companies—Guideline Travels Holidays, TripShope Travel Technologies and Dook Travels—as part of its growth strategy. It

has also secured a non-controlling 13% stake in Eco Hotels and Resorts Ltd.

"Among the interested investors, one is domestic, and the other is foreign. In terms of usage of funds, at least more than 50% of the funds will be for acquisition of non-air related companies as we are already very strong in air business. We will use the rest of the funds for marketing activities for the company," he said.

In the non-air category EaseMyTrip said that it is eye-

ing opportunities in business-to-business, business-to-consumer and business-to-business-consumer categories, in addition to hotels, holidays, bus and cabs.

However, it is not looking for opportunities related to train transportation.

"Besides train segment, there are a bunch of people we are speaking to right now and this is why we are doing the fund raise," he added.

On Wednesday, the company also announced the

launch of its new subsidiary, EaseMyTrip Insurance Broker Pvt Ltd, to try and tap into the Indian insurance market.

The company said diversifying into insurance made sense as it has found a 75% overlap in its 20-million customer base between customers who are booking an air ticket online and those who are buying insurance.

"This is the first time we are doing something outside the travel space, we feel extremely comfortable working with digital goods. We want to stay in digital goods and high-order value category, so insurance fits in perfectly. Insurance is an asset-light, inventory-light investment model," Pitti said.

The company has been working on a technology for deploying the insurance business for 7-8 months and expects to unveil the new company to the public in 3-4 months. The product will be offered as part of air ticket bookings but will provide the entire insurance range as well—including motor vehicle, health and life insurance.

S&P downgrades Vedanta's credit rating

S&P on Friday downgraded the long-term credit rating of Vedanta Resources to SD, or selective default, calling the company's recent bond restructuring exercise a distressed transaction.

This is the second downgrade for the mining company this week after Moody's downgraded its corporate family rating to Caa3 from Caa2. "We view Vedanta Resources'

just concluded liability management exercise, which involved three of its US dollar-denominated bonds, as a distressed transaction," S&P analysts noted.

Vedanta Resources, the London-based parent of India's Vedanta Ltd, on Friday said that it has transferred a consent fee due to its bondholders, kickstarting the restructuring process. The restructuring will see the redemption date of three of Vedanta's outstanding bond series delayed by 29-52 months in exchange of a part-

payment upfront, higher interest rates on two bond series, and a consent fee equal to 2% of the principal.

The company said it will make the part-payments as early as Friday and no later than the deadline of 7 February.

On Tuesday, Moody's senior vice president Kaustubh Chhabal said: "We view the debt restructuring as default avoidance and assess that the creditors have incurred an economic loss with respect to the original promise. We consider the transaction to be a distressed

exchange under our criteria, which underpins our downgrade of VRL's ratings." S&P had downgraded Vedanta Resources just last month to CCC from CC as the company started seeking investors' consent for the bond restructuring exercise. It had warned back then that once the plan is implemented, the company's long-term credit rating could fall to SD.

The rating agency noted that a refinancing risk remains for Vedanta Resources despite a stronger capital structure post the transaction.
